- Hotsec database usually the filename is in format Hotsec_db_xx.xx.xx_yy, where xx is the release date and yy language (English language doesn't have yy).
 Database installation package creates empty Hotsec database and installs Firebird database engine if it is not found in the system.
- Hotsec core usually the filename is in format Hotsec_xx.xx.xx_yy, where xx is the release date and yy language (English language doesn't have yy).
 Core installation package contains Hotsec core server plus all the services needed to communicate between Hotsec core and hardware.
- 3) Hotsec client usually the filename is in format Hotsec_Client_xx.xx.xx_yy, where xx is the release date and yy language (English language doesn't have yy). Hotsec client is user interface for Hotsec server. If you are just using Hotsec as a client connected to server you don't need to install anything else besides the client.

The installation order is not important if you want to install the full package of Hotsec software (database, core and client).

Hotsec database installation process

After launching the Hotsec_db package the following welcome message should appear

It is good to install only the features allowed on your license because other features don't work if they are not allowed by the license. For systems using only Paradox EVO panels just check "core server" and "paradox service".
